The Food Pantry fed 573 people during the month of July, 152 more people than in June. There seems to be no rhyme or reason for the change in our numbers. We did feed 71 new recipients this month.

The Food Pantry recipients are usually very grateful for our assistance with food and I wanted to share an example of this. Sometimes when there is a case of need we allow a friend to pick up food for them if they are unable to come themselves. Such is the case of a woman who has visited the Food Pantry for some time. Please note that all personal details have been omitted to protect her privacy:

Hi, My name is...and I am 67 years old, born in 1943. I have diabetes and gout and can no longer walk to your church because of foot pain and swelling. Could you please give my friend...some food for me? My friend...is really my angel and has been helping me so much. Anything will be appreciated because I actually am out of food. My prayers are with your congregation, and the help you give is life saving for many people! Thank you.

Important note: Our friend Jeanie Stead, who has been a faithful volunteer at the Food Pantry for many years now, fell and broke her hip. Please pray for a quick and complete recovery for her! Jeanie has been a very important part of this ministry, along with her husband Ken. Without Jeanie's help each Friday, the Food Pantry is looking for people to step up and consistently lend a hand. September Prophecy Propadeutics

The Rapture -- Is it real, or is it rubbish? According to Old Testament Scripture, it is very real. Did you know that that the when God came down on Mt. Sinai and Moses went up (Exodus 19), this was a picture or foretype of the coming rapture? Consider these parallels between the Exodus passage and Paul's writings in the New Testament. In Exodus:

- God came down from heaven in a cloud and His voice was heard, sounding like thunder.
- The people were consecrated then gathered together as a people holy to the Lord
- They were only allowed to go up to the mountain when a ram's horn (trumpet) sounded a long blast

Now read 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17: "And the Lord himself shall descend from heaven, with a loud shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first, then we who are still alive will be caught up in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air."

These two passages are but a tiny sample of the scriptures that speak of the rapture. I firmly believe in the rapture, and suspect it's not far off. I hope your studies of scripture will convince you that the rapture is real as well.
